Thank you to the many who have prayed for Thailand during the recent civil unrest in the capital. We were not affected in Phang Nga but realize that at any time it may well escalate to involve the whole country. Please continue to uphold us in your prayers.

Over the past two years we have been grateful to use the four rooms located at the church. Pastor Prakop and his family have now decided to separate the church property from the Eaglesrest foundation property and so we are in the process of vacating them. That leaves Eaglesrest with Tinno House (their family home) and an old shop building on the road front which needs a lot of work to transform into a workable office/school area. (see photos which show the building we will have to renovate as well as our helper Lin. She has already proved to be a true blessing for Eaglesrest)

We do not know where the Lord will lead in the months ahead and look to Him to show us each step as we go forward in His strength. Meanwhile we also pray for land to build a permanent home for Eaglesrest to continue to serve God's Asian servants. If it is not to be here then we know He has an even greater plan!

This month John Hartwick (Australia) will come for three weeks to assist Rommel with renovations and carpentry jobs around the remaining property. We are very grateful for his assistance.
